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Workforce Solutions Cameron honored at the Texas Workforce Commission Board Awards

Virtual – Workforce Solutions (WFS) Cameron was honored at the Texas Workforce Commission’s Board Awards presentation that was held virtually on January 12, 2021. WFS Cameron was among three boards that were recognized with the Texas HireAbility Award. The Award honors Boards that have successfully promoted employment opportunities for talented and dedicated Texans with disabilities. The purpose of this award is to recognize outstanding local HireAbility campaign efforts that have benefitted both job seekers with disabilities and employers who hire them.

Some of the HireAbility efforts undertaken included raising awareness on the importance of having an inclusive workforce through targeted outreach projects designed for school districts, hosting events for employers, and creating engaging social media campaigns to discuss HireAbility efforts. Employer Incentive Seminars are hosted regularly to identify labor force needs, highlight programs and resources, and encourage the hiring of individuals with disabilities.

WFS Cameron supports this effort with year-round activities that create a pipeline of talent built by individuals with disabilities. To further this effort, WFS Cameron participates in the annual Summer Earn and Learn Program, collaborates with VR on the yearly National Disability Employment Awareness Month (NDEAM) event, and showcases VR services and programs to support the current workforce.

Workforce Solutions Cameron is among 28 local workforce boards located throughout the state serving Cameron County. The primary goal of TWC and the workforce boards is to meet the needs of Texas employers and workers through locally-designed, market-driven workforce development initiatives and services.
